Youthfront Neighborhood is seeking a part-time Youth Pastor to join a growing, neighborhood-based ministry in Argentine, a historically rich and close-knit community in Kansas City, Kansas. This position is ideal for someone who is passionate about working with adolescents (6th–12th grade) and eager to learn about Christian community development in a lower-resourced, urban neighborhood setting.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Argentine Youth Good Life Youth Group
 - Disciple youth with a focus on their emotional, spiritual, and social development
 - Implement a discipleship program for youth in Kansas City, KS, including a weekly, evening youth gathering (currently on Monday nights) for middle and high school youth
 - Shepherd the adult volunteermentor team and set them up as successful partners in ministry
 - Meet and partner with parents and guardians of youth and invite them into connection with YFN
 - Build relationships with community partners such as Argentine Middle School and J.C. Harmon High School staff, occasionally support youth's activities at their school sporting events or music programs.
- Snack Shack KC
 - Ensure an on-going adult presence at Snack Shack KC 3-4 afternoons per week, building relationships with youth while maintaining firm boundaries as well as serving families and community members
 - Oversee day-to-day operations of Snack Shack KC: running the snack counter, doing inventory, shopping, and handling of funds
- Summer Youth Ministry
 - Recruit students, implement program and identify service opportunities for Amp'd Up Summer, our 8 week youth summer discipleship program
 - Be present with Argentine youth at Youthfront Camp as a cabin leader
- Youthfront Neighborhood Team
 - Attend weekly Youthfront corporate and team meetings
